

Proposed Changes to BVAA By-Laws for 2018 AGM:

Under Membership:

Section II, Family members, reads:

II. FAMILY MEMBERS

- a) The term family shall be defined as: Parent(s) or legal guardians(s) of one or more children that are registered in an included program, living at the same residence as the registered athlete (as per the address of the registered athlete).
- b) Family membership entitles the family to one vote at Monthly, Annual General and Special Meetings of the BVAA. Only family members over the age of 18 years may use this vote. Notification of all meetings is assumed by the BVAA.
- c) Family members can serve on any committee.
- d) Term of membership shall be one year from date of final registration for sport their child or children are registered for.
- e) In the event that the Association is unable to offer a sport at a particular division or age level, in any given year, and the registered player or participant registers in another association for that sport, the family membership will continue as if that registered player or participant was registered with the Association.

Change to:

II. FAMILY MEMBERS

- a) The term family shall be defined as: Parent(s) or legal guardians(s) of one or more children that are registered in an included program, living at the same residence as the registered athlete (as per the address of the registered athlete).

- e) Families whose children **only** participate in power skating or sport camps (e.g. baseball camp, hockey camp) are not considered BVAA members.
- f) In the event that the Association is unable to offer a sport at a particular division or age level, in any given year, and the registered player or participant registers in another association for that sport, the family membership will continue as if that registered player or participant was registered with the Association.
